Simplified overview of codicological analysis with regards to production units (acc. to Andrist et al. 2013) by Lea D. Pokorny.

Result: There are two production unit from the late 14th century, PU2 (ff. 1r-7r7) and PU3 (ff. 91r-128r). In addition, the table includes a unit from the late 13th century, PU1 (ff. 8r-90r), two production units from ca. 1400, PU4 (f. 7r12-7v) and PU5 (f. 90v1-10; later deleted), and one production unit from ca. 1500, PU6 (f. 90v11-19).
